Early in the morning we toured Blue Mound State Park hoping to see the bison herds, one day they were in range for us to see and the other day they were grazing the back of the prairie. The backdrop of the park is beautiful, and our guide explained the rock formations and other facts about the park.

Our next stop was the History Center which includes many historical items from Rock County and the largest collection of Nutcrackers in the Midwest. We were fortunate to have Betty Mann give us the tour of the Nutcrackers, she has donated the largest portion of the over 4500 nutcrackers in the collection. Luverne is developing their tourism destination around the Nutcracker theme, including stunningly painted Nutcracker statues around the city.

The historical Palace Theatre was next on the itinerary. Shawn, the Executive Director of the theatre explained the history and encouraged us to come for a movie or a live performance. Then we were off to the Hinkly home which was built in 1892 by R.B. Hinkly. The beautiful Sioux Quartzite faced, 12 room house is an attribute to his foresight and artistic skills.

We are all aware that Minnesota has over 10,000 lakes, well Rock County doesn't have any. So, a very ingenious community created The Lake, previously known as the Creamery Pond. It has a beach, great fishing, a campground and cute tiny houses to rent. It was a fun day which also included shopping downtown, a delicious lunch at Sterlings and a vummy piece of pie at the 75 Diner.

Southern Charm | April 17-22, 2023

Antebellum, Prohibition, and maritime history will come alive in historic homes, in museums, and on aircraft carriers. A shrimping expedition will both educate us and tickle our taste buds, while the exceptional care provided at a sea turtle hospital will tug at our heartstrings. Our time in Georgia and South Carolina will also take us into the world of America's Gilded Age elite on Jekyll Island, introduce us to 260 years of history in Savannah's National Historic Landmark District, and Iull us with the clipclop of horses' hooves on a Charleston carriage tour. Get ready to witness the contrasting life of the Charleston elite and enslaved during the 1700s and step back in time to the roaring 20s!
